Library Visits

You will come to the library when you need to do research, write a paper, or with your class. We have desktop computers that you may use.

You may visit the library to read or check out a book either for research or to read for pleasure.

But REMEMBER!

Do not bring food or drinks into the Titan Library ever!

You may not talk on your cell phone in the library.

You must have a pass with **YOUR NAME** on it and you must sign in when you get here.

Please respect the library furnishings.

Book Check and Operations

Books are checked out for 2 weeks. You may renew as often as needed.

Fines are \$.10 per day after the due date. Lost books cost the replacement price of a new book.

Copies/printing are \$.10 each. No color copies.

Library Sections

Along the wall on the west end of the library all the way to the American flag are the **REFERENCE** books.

- Not for check out
- Very expensive to replace
- Limited number of copies
- Will be **VALUABLE** to you!

The short stacks on the west end of the library contain the **Biography** books, both individual and collective.

- Shelved in ABC order by the last name of the subject of the book.
- Good resources

Beginning at the Alabama state flag, the books that go along the walls of the east end of the library are the **Non-fiction** books.

- Shelved by the Dewey Decimal number
- Good resources
- Have to be updated more than any section in the library.

The short stacks on the east end of the library are the **Fiction** books.

- Very popular section in the library
- Shelved in ABC order by the author's last name
- **Story Collections** are shelved at the end of the Fiction section.

Magazines

Magazines are housed in the racks near the exits to the courtyard. They are in ABC order by title.

They are not for check-out.

Enjoy them when you visit the library.

Newspaper

We subscribe to the Gadsden Times. We only get weekday papers (M-F).

It is not for check-out.

Enjoy the Times when you visit the library.
